Copies of the DNR-Division of Forestry (DOF) 2020-2024 Five-Year Schedule of Timber Sales for the Coastal Region's Mat-Su Area and Kenai / Kodiak Area are available for public review. This document is a scoping document that outlines the proposed timber sale activity to be undertaken on State land over the next five years. This document is not a decision document.

The public is invited to comment on any aspect of the Five-Year Schedule of Timber Sales. Comments concerning the proposed timber sale areas need to be received no later than close of business on September 7, 2020. This document can be reviewed at the DOF offices in Soldotna and Palmer.
