**Five-Year Schedule of Timber Sales (FYSTS)  
FY 2014 to FY 2018**

***Introduction***

The Five-Year Schedule of Timber Sales (FYSTS) lists proposed timber sales on State Forest and State forest classified lands in the Fairbanks and Kantishna Management Areas. The schedule provides a time line that identifies the sales, their estimated volumes and their general locations. At a minimum, the Division of Forestry (DOF) must develop a schedule every two years. The schedule may be written annually if market and stand conditions warrant a more frequent change. It is designed to provide the general public, local governments, other agencies and the timber industry a view of what DOF may be offering on State lands managed by Fairbanks Area Forestry for the next five years based on the State's fiscal year. The Five-Year Schedule provides a basis for agency and public comment and identification of issues although it is not developed as a decision document for particular timber sales. The schedule provides DOF with a guide in considering, designing, allocating state resources and conducting timber sales. Listing a proposed sale does not mean a decision has been made to go forward with the sale but instead solicits input on sale planning and on particular concerns to be addressed in sale design.

The timber sales included in this schedule are part of a management philosophy that ensures a sustained yield of renewable forest resources and the integrated use of forest lands by a myriad of users, as guided by State statutes and regulations, the Tanana Valley State Forest Management Plan and the Tanana Basin Area Plan. Sales are located across a wide area of the forest land base and vary in size, species composition and development requirements. Emergency salvage sales, market conditions, sale preparation problems, logistical constraints, funding and other considerations may cause some proposed sales to be dropped or moved between years.

Generally, the Division of Forestry may not offer a timber sale unless it has appeared on at least one Five-Year Schedule preceding the sale. Sales are exempt from this requirement if they are 160 acres or less; salvage sales, or emergency sales in areas with fire, insect, or other natural threats. It is the policy of the Division of Forestry however, to include all sales on at least the Five-Year Schedule preceding the sale whenever possible unless waiting for the schedule will cause substantial losses of economic value on salvage sales, allow for the spread of damaging insects, or preclude a local economic enterprise or forest management project that is in the state's best interest. (References: AS 38.05.113, AS 38.05.117, and 11 AAC 71.010)

## ***Schedule Review Process***

The Review Draft Five-Year Schedule of Timber Sales is submitted for review and comment to several agencies. Comments are requested about timber sales in year one and two from; Alaska Department of Fish and Game, Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority, Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation, Division of Mining, Land and Water, and the Division of Agriculture. The comments are used to draft a Forest Land Use Plan (FLUP) for those specific timber sales (AS 38.05.112). The FLUP gives site specific information for each sale describing the location, estimated timber volume, harvest methods, reforestation plan, access, and other potential uses of the sale area. A FLUP is required for any commercial timber sale of ten acres or larger. The schedule followed by individual FLUPs and a preliminary finding that the sale is in the state's best interest is then distributed for review by the public. Public comments are considered, and revisions made to the FLUP as appropriate before a final finding is made that the sale is in the state's best interest. Sales where the FLUPs have been previously reviewed by the public and agencies are noted on the schedule. Sales that have been reviewed and are currently available over the counter are also listed.

## ***Sustained Yield***

The Alaska Land Act requires that state land be managed for sustained yield, which is "the achievement and maintenance in perpetuity of a high level of annual or regular periodic output of the various renewable resources of the state land consistent with multiple use" (AS 38.04.910). In each of the years covered in this schedule, the total volume of wood proposed for harvest is far below the potential sustained harvest level determined in the Timber Inventory of State Forest Lands in the Tanana Valley (Hanson, 2013). This publication indicates that the annual sustained yield levels for the Fairbanks and Kantishna Management areas are approximately 7,700 acres and 14,000,000 cubic feet. Thus the proposed average yearly harvest for this schedule, at 1,073 acres and 2,223,881 cubic feet, constitutes less than 14% of the potential sustained harvest by area and 16% by volume. Included in the acres and volume for this five year schedule is a long term proposed value added sale that is described below. Not included in the volumes are the Over-The-Counter Sales which have been previously reviewed.

The law, AS 41.17.220 – 230, requires Division of Forestry to develop a management plan for the Tanana Valley State Forest. The management plan guides many of the Division’s management actions. The FYSTS is consistent with the guidelines and direction established in the Tanana Valley State Forest (TVSF) Management Plan. Some of the sales may be for areas outside of the boundaries of the TVSF, and are proposed on state owned forestry classified lands; these sales are consistent with the Tanana Basin Area Plan (TBAP.) Both the TVSF Management Plan and the TBAP are available for review at the Fairbanks Area Office.

***Transportation***

Forest access roads will be constructed to meet standards stated within the TVSF Management Plan, the TBAP and Best Management Practices for the Alaska Forest Resources and Practices Act. Road construction averages about 7.5 miles a year and is divided roughly 66% winter and 33% all-season road. Individual proposed road segments constructed each year are generally less than 2 miles in length. Most all-season road construction is either spur or secondary road. In year one of the schedule, sale NC-1543 includes roughly 1.25 miles of winter road construction. In year two of the schedule, NC-1551 includes 0.8 miles of secondary road construction. Other sales in the first two years require considerably less, if any, road construction and AFRPA standards will be set and enforced. Increased road construction may occur if the Value Added Sale is pursued. This will be addressed in a separate Best Interest Finding.

***Value Added Sale***

The Alaska Division of Forestry received a request from Superior Pellet Fuels, LLC to provide a Negotiated Timber Sale for Value Added Processing under Alaska Statute (AS) 38.05.123 on November 26<sup>th</sup> 2013. Since the request was received the Division of Forestry has been developing a response by assessing timber stand inventory and assessing transportation networks to determine viability of the requested ten year sale duration and volume requested. At the request of the Director of Division of Forestry the Large Projects Team began investigating the potential of supplying this request from the Fairbanks resource area.

Results of the investigation determined that there exists a currently underutilized volume of mixed specie stands in the Fairbanks locale. These timber stands include varying compositions of White Spruce, Black Spruce, Aspen, Birch and Balsam Poplar. Approximately 700 acres per year of timber is included in the FYSTS for this value added sale request. The value added sale schedule table and vicinity map show the entire 10 year period of proposed sales. The actual extent or duration of the value added sale has yet to be determined.

Further investigations for developing this proposed negotiated timber sale are ongoing, subject to industry interest and Division of Forestry time constraints. Inclusion of this proposed sale to the Fairbanks Area Forestry 2014-18 FYSTS provides interested parties with information, currently available, regarding the sale. Detailed information and opportunity to review and comment upon the proposal will be provided in a specific Best Interest Finding and Forest Land Use Plan that the Division of Forestry will develop for this proposed timber sale.





*Vicinity Maps Years 1-5*


