Notice of Preliminary Decision under  
AS 38.05.035 and AS 38.05.945

The Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry, gives formal notice under AS 38.05.945 (a)(3) that the Division has made preliminary decisions under AS 38.05.035(e) regarding the following commercial timber sales:

The proposed project is located within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; information regarding it is as follows:

**Mile 127:** Section 34, Township 1 North, Range 13 West and Sections 3 and 4, Township 1 South, Range 13 West Seward Meridian.

**Garden:** Section 25, Township 1 North, Range 13 West, Seward Meridian

Before timber sales may be held, the Director of the Division of Forestry must make a written Final Decision that these timber sales serve the best interest of the State. This Decision will set out the facts and applicable policies upon which the Director bases his determination that offering these timber sales will or will not best serve the interest of the State. The Final Decision is expected to be available to the public after December 26, 2014.

The Division of Forestry is requesting comments for these projects from state resource agencies, the public, and other interested parties. To be considered, written comment must be submitted to the Division of Forestry, 42499 Sterling Highway, Soldotna, AK 99669 on or before December 26, 2014.

Comments must be received at the Division of Forestry no later than December 26, 2014 in order to be considered in the Final Decision of whether or not this project will go forward in whole or in part. To be eligible to appeal a final decision a person must have provided written comment by December 10, 2014.
