- Equipment, Tools/Supplies, or Safety Improvements refer to the instruction manual for description of allowable items.
- Training both Wildland and Structural
- <u>Communications Equipment</u> (MUST BE P25 COMPLIANT) refer to the instruction manual for description of allowable items.

Wildland is the priority, but structural items can requested.
