

# Alaska Division of Forestry Interactive Scoping Map

This map is intended as a tool for the public to identify specific locations and add text describing why those locations are important to you.

- Click "Edit" to add a point marking a significant location
- Click "Map Layers" to turn data like roads or boundaries on/off
- Click "Basemap" to change the background map
- Click the arrow to see the "Information" tab, which describes how Forest Management Units are Labeled
