# ALASKA BASIC WILDLAND FIREFIGHTER ACADEMY TRAINING APPLICATION — APRIL 18 – 29, 2025 IN CHUGIAK, ALASKA

The Alaska Basic Wildland Firefighter Academy is a DOF Training Program funded by the State of Alaska

This application will be scored and rated in the selection process for applicants. Wildland Fire Agency sponsorship is required.

Application is due at your local Division of Forestry & Fire Protection Office no later than March 15, 2025 (early applications will be accepted)

Travel to and from the Academy will be coordinated and provided by the Statewide Training Office.

ACADEMY OVERVIEW— The academy will be conducted at the Birchwood Camp in Chugiak, Alaska from Saturday, April 19<sup>th</sup> to Tuesday, April 29<sup>th</sup> (April 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> as well as the afternoon of April 29<sup>th</sup> will be student travel days).

Participants will arrive on April 18th to check-in and go through orientation before classes begin on April 19th.

The academy will consist of a closed campus. Participants will remain in designated areas. Sleeping accommodation will be provided in Chugiak and will be camping or agency provided housing when available. Participants will be provided with meals and refreshments. A typical academy day will start with physical fitness training, followed by 10-12 hours of classroom and/or practical exercise instruction, with meal breaks. Evening sessions may be conducted throughout the academy. Participants are expected to take part in all activities. Little personal time will be allotted during the academy. The academy will be hard work, and successful participants will be immersed in a rewarding learning and skill-building experience. Successful completion of the academy could earn the applicant a spot on a fuels crew/module. Working on the fuels crew/module will require a commitment of approximately 4 months with the opportunity to work later into the fall, as well as the opportunity to take Initial Attack or Extended Attack fire assignments as the fire season dictates.

#### **Application Requirements:**

- 1. You must have a valid/active email account which you check regularly. Email is how we will communicate with you before and after the Academy.
- 2. You must have already taken the basic wildland firefighter courses (S-130, S-190, I-100, IS-700 & L-180), have a valid Red Card and be Firefighter Type 2 (FFT2) qualified. If you have taken the Red Card class and have NOT attended your field day or taken your pack test at the time of application, please make sure you complete these obligations BEFORE the start of the Academy.
